BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR, STAFF, AND OVERHEAD

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for immediate basic burial, dignified cremations, and forwarding or receiving remains.) This fee includes the following:

- Personnel available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year to respond to initial call
- Conducting the arrangement conference
- Planning the funeral and consulting with the family
- Providing shelter of your loved one
- Coordinating service plans with cemetery, crematory, and/or other parties involved in the final disposition of the deceased
- Clerical assistance and Preparing and filing of necessary notices; obtaining necessary authorizations and permits

- Covering overhead, including facility and equipment maintenance, inventory costs, insurance and administration expenses and governmental compliance
- Notification of social security administration/Medical/Medicare/SSI/SSA
- Courtesy Guest Book and Easels for Viewing and Services.
- Courtesy White Gloves and White Bands for Graveside Service

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial. You will not be charged for embalming if you do not select it.

Includes basic services of funeral director, staff and overhead; local transportation of the deceased to the mortuary; basic sanitation, casketing of remains, delivery of casketed remains to the place of immediate burial, and refrigeration. If you select this limited service option, please understand that immediate burial does not include casket or any ceremony or services. We perform the scheduling of Immediate burial at our convenience.

DIGNIFIED SUNNYSIDE CREMATION (Direct Cremation)**\$1,990.00**

Includes an alternative container that encase the body and can be made of materials like cardboard Container (with or without an outside covering). We also offer a selection of cremation-oriented caskets. Our charges for Dignified Cremation (without ceremony or service) include transfer of deceased to mortuary, transportation to crematory, refrigeration and basic services of staff. The Crematory fee and durable transportation urn is included. Additional fees apply for preparation for identification and may apply for facility use.

FORWARDING REMAINS**FROM \$2,850.00**

This charge includes removal of remains, basic service of staff, necessary authorizations, embalming, use of preparation room and transportation to local airport or other place of shipment within a 45-mile radius (excluding shipping charges and shipping container). This charge does not include visitation or ceremonies.

RECEIVING REMAINS**FROM \$2,550.00**

This charge includes basic services of staff, transportation from local airport or other local shipping destination and local transportation of remains to cemetery or crematory. This charge does not include full overhead relating to visitation or ceremonial services.
